



# Learning at Home On Site Support

Dear Jackson Families,

Below is our schedule for having students return to Jackson for on site support of our learning at home. All planning to get staff and students back in our building has been done with staff and student safety as the first priority. We will not be running normal block rotations, and cannot ensure that students get their classroom teachers. Students are broken into four colour groups and given a week day. For example, a student invited to attend **Tuesday yellow** would mean that Tuesdays are their day to come in and they assemble in the morning at the west entry (top of the metal staircase from the back parking lot) for their daily health check at 9:15. We would anticipate seeing a **Tuesday yellow** student *every Tuesday*. If you have not heard from Jackson as to your student's day, please call the office. If at any point your family decides to withdraw from on site support of learning at home, please call the office.

Our start and end times are the same as usual (9:15AM and 3:30PM). Students will get multiple supervised breaks, as well as a supervised lunch.

We are excited to welcome students back in this limited capacity, and feel confident we are doing so in a safe manner for both staff and students.
