
The Student Learning Survey (SLS) has been administered every year in BC public schools since 2001. Prior to the 2016-17 school year, the SLS was known as the Student Satisfaction Survey. The SLS provides feedback on the implementation of the new curriculum, learning environments, student wellness and satisfaction, student belonging and engagement as well as career preparation. The SLS is the only source of province-wide information regarding students' learning experience through the perspective of students, parent/guardians and school staff. Schools and districts use the SLS to make informed decisions around long-term planning, goal setting as well as providing individual students personalized support.

The online SLS is usually administered in class for BC public school students in grades 4, 7, 10 and 12; however, due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, students can now complete the SLS at home, online. Students have until **12:00 AM PST**, **June 30th 2020** to complete the SLS.

To have your student to complete the survey you will need:

- ✓ You student's Personal Education Number (PEN). You can find this unique, 9 digit number on <u>Student</u> <u>Connect</u> or <u>Parent Connect</u>.
- ✓ A tablet or computer with an up-to-date internet browser.
- ✓ Approximately 30 minutes.

When your student is ready, click <u>here</u>, and login (see screenshot example). To navigate through the SLS, students can click the arrow in the bottom right corner to proceed (and the arrow in the bottom left corner to go back).

When your student has completed the Ministry of Education's set of questions, a page "Help is available" will display. This page has been included to provide different avenues of help available for children that may need supports. Your student also has the ability to select an option to share concerns with school administration.
