Dear Jackson Families,

Welcome back to school! Hopefully you all enjoyed a restful summer filled with quality family time. My name is Mr. Gord Ritchie and it's my privilege to be the Principal of J.L. Jackson Secondary School. On behalf of myself, Vice Principal, Mrs. Gloria Cox, and our entire staff, we are excited for you to be joining our learning community this September.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

The first day of school is **Wednesday, September 4** and will be a half day starting at 9:14am with dismissal at 12:30pm. Thursday September 5 will be a full day of school, starting at 9:14am with dismissal at 3:30pm.

Students should come to school on the first day with some basic supplies for the day:

- A three-ring binder
- Lined loose-leaf paper
- Pens/pencils/eraser

When students arrive, there will be **Block A Class Lists** posted in the main foyer. **Students are to double check** these lists to ensure they know which location to go to for Block A.

During Block A, students will be provided with plenty of information about our school, including locker assignments and student schedules. Students will then rotate through their remaining first semester courses, meeting each of their teachers, and finding out more information about their classes (*including additional supplies that may be required*).
