Health Checks, Illness, and When to Stay Home

Within normal educational settings, children and staff will often have influenza or other respiratory viruses with symptoms similar to COVID-19. For this reason, students and staff who are ill with fever or infectious respiratory symptoms of any kind need to stay home until they are no longer symptomatic, or they have been assessed by a health care provider to exclude COVID-19.

If a person is found to be a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the school, public health staff will determine how to proceed, and the school will play a supportive role in their process.

Parents are required to complete the following form through the MyEd BC parent portal and will acknowledge the parent's responsibility to do daily at home health checks and to keep their child(ren) at home if they are unwell.

If you answered "Yes" to any of the questions and the symptoms are not related to a pre-existing condition (i.e. Allergies/Asthma) your child should not come to school. If there is a pre-existing condition answer "No" on form.		
If your child is experiencing any symptoms of illness, contact your health-care provider for further assessment. This includes 8- 1-1, or a primary care provider like a physician or nurse practitioner. If you answered "YES" to questions 2 or 3, use the COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool to determine if you should be tested for COVID-19.		

In the event that a child has a fever, they must remain at home until at least 24 hours after they no longer have a fever (temperature of 38°C or higher) or signs of a fever without the use of fever-reducing medicine (i.e., Tylenol).
