

- -Offered to students who enjoy a more traditional PHE program
- -Mainstream sports skills are a focus for evaluation of fundamental movement skills (e.g. basketball, volleyball, football, rugby, ultimate frisbee, badminton, pickleball, etc.)
- -More focus on competition and group/team games

PE OPTIONS

Active for Life 9

- -Offered to students who are looking for an alternative to a traditional PHE program
- -Some mainstream sports are still covered, but typically ones that require less complex skills, such as volleyball, badminton, ultimate frisbee, pickleball etc.
- -Alternative lifelong activities are also introduced such as disc golf, bocce, tennis baseball, low organizational games, etc.
- -In general, the course is **not less intense**, **it's just less competitive**




